



## German Topics of Study

Year 6 Revision of Year 5 material; free time activities; responding to questions; saying what you like doing; talking about school subjects and describing teachers; giving opinions; time and days of the week; prepositions; what there is and isn't in a town; buying snacks and drinks; holiday plans; future tense. Throughout Year 6, material will be revised as and when necessary, and particular emphasis is laid on grammar and pronunciation.

Year 7 YEAR 7 Revision of Year 6 material; past tense; describing what you did on holiday; weather in present and past tenses; problems with accommodation; films and TV programmes; reading preferences; food and healthy living; daily routine. Throughout Year 7 there is greater emphasis on extending vocabulary, practising role-plays and increasing accuracy in speaking and writing.

Year 7

Year 8 YEAR 8 Grammatical confidence and oral fluency continue to be promoted. Previously learnt topic material and structures are revised, and a few remaining topics (such as health and illness, future careers, activities and facilities) are introduced. Exam techniques are taught and, as in other subjects, there is a gradual increase in the use of past papers in preparation for the practice, mock and summer examinations. The importance of vocabulary revision is stressed. Pupils regularly practise for the role-play section and topics of the speaking test.

Year 8
